 - Processing reimbursement requests received to date today
 - Received questions from auditor regarding 2022-2023 financial statements
 - Reached out to previous Senior Directors of Finance -they said they would take a look
 - Proposing forming a temporary volunteer working group or electing more than two Junior Directors of Finance just this year to financial records from previous years
 - Necessary to apply for UTSU funding in the next cycle
 - Need to locate 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 binders (transitioning to electronic records only this year)
 - Exploring obtaining a NUS credit card to allow members to make high-cost purchases without paying out-of-pocket and waiting for reimbursement
 - Need approval for purchases first and then returning receipt to finance
 - Speak to financial advisor regarding acquiring credit card
 - Reminder to run planned fundraisers, as approved budgets are based on anticipated profit from those events
 - Proposing investing in a <u>Square Reader</u> (\$69) to facilitate payments for fundraisers. Free plan available: "Sell in person, online, over the phone or out in the field. No setup fees or monthly fees only pay when you take a payment."

Credit card present When a customer taps, inserts or swipes their credit card in person. Visa, Mastercard, American Express and international credit cards all cost the same rate.	2.65% per transaction
Debit card present When a customer taps or inserts their debit card in person.	0.75% + 7¢ per debit transaction
Card not present When a customer makes a purchase through your Online Store, Online Checkout, eCommerce API or pays an invoice online.	2.9% + 30¢ per transaction
Keyed in When you manually key in your customer's card details or use a card on file.	3.4% + 15¢ per transaction
